HOC Standing Committee on Psychoactive Substances

Terms of Reference

Purpose:

To coordinate and prioritize HOC activities regarding psychoactive substances (includes alcohol, tobacco, legal, and illegal psychoactive substances).

This will include but not be limited to:

- Proposing policy changes to HOC for further action.
- Representing HOC in related committees or organizations.
- Developing materials such as letters, discussion papers, and presentations for HOC.
- Keeping aware of new developments related to psychoactive substances and communicating these to HOC.
- Advising on research priorities.
- Linking with mental health, cancer, injury, child and youth health, and other initiatives as they relate to psychoactive substances.

Reporting:

This committee reports to HOC as a whole.

Membership:

HOC members and others as invited by the committee.

Corresponding members (those who cannot participate but are interested in keeping informed of committee activities) are welcome.

Decision Making:

Will be by consensus.

Organization:

The committee will select a chair and recorder.

These positions will be reviewed annually.

Subcommittees may be established for specific tasks or on an ongoing basis.

Meetings:

Meetings will be usually held by teleconference, although face-to-face meetings will be occasionally arranged.

The committee will determine meeting frequency and duration.

Members will be responsible for their own expenses.
